## Tri-County Celebrates 75 Years!

Tri-County Credit Union, originally known as Continental Credit Union, was opened for business in 1936. It was located originally under the steps in the old Scott Paper-Marinette. Ed Rynning conducted business during lunch for the hourly employees. As things picked up, Ed hired Harriet Jones, the 1<sup>st</sup> employee, and she worked part time in the morning. Later, she went to full time. As the credit union got busier & busier, sometimes Harriet would return in the evenings to finish her work for that day. Many will remember Harriet by her many years of dedicated service to our members and her care &

concern for each member and their family. She worked for 19 years, retired, came back part time and stayed on an additional 8 years. They had a windowless office that was located under the #4 paper machine. When this machine was not up and running, the office was closed because there was no heat. The paper company eventually remodeled and expanded a closet to make a second room for the growing credit union. The current building was occupied in 1978 and later remodeled to add offices.

In 75 Years of operation, we have had just 3

managers starting with Edward Rynning. He was the person who initially started the credit union to help the employees of the Continental Paper Company and served as Manager/ Treasurer for 37 years. When Ed would vacation in Florida Doug Enstrom helped out & filled in until his return. Then Doug took the reins full time from 1973 to 1989. We have continued to grow and remain strong with Carl Lang serving for more than 20 years. These men have been solid in making & keeping the Credit Union a stable and solid financial institution.

## Yearly Meeting

This years' Annual Meeting, held April 9<sup>th</sup> was attended by 134 members with an enjoyable evening of good food and a wide variety of prizes. Maureen Landerman, Robert Rynning and Al Mans were voted unanimously to remain on the Board of Directors for 3 more years.

John McClelland, Chairman of the Board, presented a Certificate of Appreciation to Robert Rynning and family in honor of their service and dedication for the past 75 years.

The 50/50 Drawings were won by Donald Bolen & Rita Anglehart.

Pam Berg was introduced and gave a talk about the ½ Marathons she participates in and runs on behalf of local individuals who are battling cancer. She was raising money and awareness for her next race in Anchorage, Alaska. She completed this on June 18th. A special drawing was held

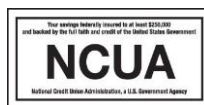

## Funds Availability Changes

Our policy is to make funds from your cash and check deposits available to you on the 1<sup>st</sup> business day after the day we receive your deposit.

In some cases, we will not make all of the funds that you deposit by check available to you in the 1<sup>st</sup> business day after the day of your deposit. Depending on the type of check that you deposit, funds may not be available until the 5<sup>th</sup> business day or longer. The first \$200 of your deposits, however, may be available on the 1<sup>st</sup> business day.

If any funds will not be available on the 1<sup>st</sup> day, we will notify you at the time of deposit or in writing. A full disclosure is available at either branch. These changes will take effect on July 21, 2011.
